2. Julia Sandstrom (the ECCC Director of Ministry Support) will deposit the checks. Julia will send all the completed registration materials collected and a single check in USD to the CHIC Office (made out the Evangelical Covenant Church).
3. The CHIC Office will then complete the registration process with UT on your behalf. Corinne Stoter is serving as the CHIC 2015 Liaison for Canada. She has been doing a lot of work to make getting to CHIC an easy and even downright enjoyable task! Please contact her (Corinne.Stoter@covenantevents.org) with any questions you might have regarding not only this process, but transportation and whatever else you may be wondering about in regards to CHIC 2015.
4. Excursions for CHIC 2015 and the Long Road to Justice Service Projects will be available in January 2015, once your church has registered. The CHIC2015 website will list available options later this fall. You can register for these options on line and can pay with a credit card so you do not need to go through the Canadian Conference Office for signups. The credit card will automatically give you the best rate for each event.

University of Tennessee | July 12-17, 2015



All Staff applicants are asked to rate their qualifications in each of the categories listed below and to indicate the specific jobs that best fit their gifts. This portion of the Staff Application will be completed online. Once you have turned in your Adult Application Form the University of Tennessee will send you information on how to complete the application process.

Administrative (i.e. office, computer, errands, accounting)

- Arrival Registration Assistant, skill in MS Excel, MS Word
- Offering Counting - Assists with counting of the offering, bank experience a plus
- Registration Table Assistant - Assist with registration of students and volunteers, skill in MS Excel, MS Word
- Staff Administration - Provides admin. assistance for Staff Coordinator, skill in MS Excel, MS Word

Recreation (i.e. equipment distribution, facilitators, assistants)

- Excursion Registration Assistant - Staff excursion registration booth
- Excursion Transportation Assistant - Help students find proper bus, work with drivers to depart on schedule, assist bus captains
- Recreation Assistant - Assist with lessons and clinics
- Skateboard Alley Assistants - Assist with skate park. Monitor the skate park and ensure the rules of the park are being followed.

Hospitality (i.e. special needs, retail sales, usher, information desk, cleanup)

- Affirmation Team - Provides support and encouragement to Staff working on campus
- Bookstore Clerks - CHIC Bookstore stock clerks
- Greeter - Greet students and adults entering and leaving the arena, and check credentials of students and adults entering the arena
- Information Centers Staff - booths around campus that provide event information
- Sign Holders - Guide students to main stage or small groups
- Sign Language Interpreter - Provide sign language interpretation for students who are hearing impaired. (Professional experience required)
- Extra Support & Special Needs Companions - Assist students with special needs
- Support & Special Needs Shuttle - Drive van to shuttle students with special needs to campus activities
- Ushers - Assist with collecting the World Relief offering

Staff Support (i.e. setup, transportation, video, sound)

- Dorm Assistants - Assist Dorm Supervisors to ensure the dorms and students are secure
- Environmental Engineering - Patrol the campus to assist in keeping the campus clean
- Security Team - Ensure the students' safety and adherence to CHIC policies
- Setup Specialists - Assist with setup of event rooms, movement of equipment, audio visual setup, etc.
- Shuttle Drivers (off campus) - Drive 15 passenger vans, shuttle adults from campus to housing
- Shuttle Drivers (on campus) - Drive 15 passenger vans, shuttle injured students or adults to and from events
- Video Camera Assistant - Assist main stage camera person (experience required)
- First Aid Team - Provide non-emergency first aid to participants (professional medical experience required)
- Welcome Party Set Up - Assist with all aspects of the Welcome Party set up (must be able to arrive one day early to CHIC)
- Welcome Party Assistant - Assist at the Welcome Party activities and clean up as needed

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CHIC?

There's nothing like CHIC! CHIC is the only conference that gathers all students from the Evangelical Covenant Church in one place for a time of Worship, Transformation, and Fun. CHIC acts as a catalyst in students' lives, helping them see the big picture of God's Kingdom and inspiring them to dive deeper in their faith—together.

WHO MAY ATTEND CHIC?

High school students are eligible to attend CHIC if:

- They will complete grade 9, 10, 11, or 12 in the 2014-2015 school year, AND
- They will be at least 15 years old as of September 1, 2015

Note: Seniors may attend CHIC 2015 even if they attended CHIC 2012

WHAT ARE THE REGISTRATION COSTS?

WHAT DO REGISTRATION FEES COVER?

HOW AM I GOING TO PAY FOR IT?

There are limited scholarships available. All scholarship requests must be processed through the CHIC Office. The application will be available for download at www.CHIC2015.org beginning August 15, 2014.

- Scholarships of up to \$150 are available from the various ethnic pastoral associations. Please contact the appropriate ethnic association representative to apply for these scholarships.
Note: A limited number of scholarships are available. Not all requests will be granted.
- Scholarships of up to \$150 are available from each CHIC Conference Liaison. Please contact the appropriate CHIC Liaison to apply for these scholarships. <http://chic2015.org/contact/>
Note: A limited number of scholarships are available. Not all requests will be granted.

Scholarships will be awarded by January 15, 2015. If your group has been awarded a scholarship, you will receive a paper voucher that must be included with your completed registration material. Each voucher is numbered and cannot be duplicated or transferred. Vouchers will be credited to the group's account before the final balance is paid.

TO WHOM SHOULD THE REGISTRATION CHECK BE WRITTEN?

Make payments directly to the church for all registration fees and the church will submit single church checks for the group. However, excursions can be paid either by church check or individually by credit card or personal check.

WHAT SORT OF SUPERVISION CAN I EXPECT?

The leaders from each church are the first point of supervision for their students. Like most camps and retreats we take our

students to we attempt to provide a healthy balance between supervision and freedom. It is mandatory for students to be at meals, base camps, and main stage and in their dorms at lights out. During the afternoon, students will have some freedom with the activities they choose, but the boundaries of where they can go will be clear.

Security and Supervision for youth at CHIC includes:

- The leaders from your church
- The University of Tennessee security team
- CHIC volunteer security team
- Each dorm has a security team led by the dorm, a Resident Supervisor, and a conference point person

WHAT ARE THE SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS?

Each conference will be assigned a dormitory for their students to sleep in. Each room will have two to three students living in them. The adult leaders will be in rooms next to the rooms of their students. Every dorm will have alternating floors for guys and girls. The University of Tennessee provides bedding and towels for each student.

HOW DO WE GET TO TENNESSEE AND TO THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE CAMPUS?

Every church is responsible for getting their students and leaders to CHIC. For groups who will be flying to CHIC, Transportation to and from Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS) is included in your registration fee. Transportation to and from Nashville's International Airport (BNA) or Atlanta's Hartsfield International Airport (ATL) is an additional fee per person round trip. It is important to check with the <http://chic2015.org> website for details and to connect with your liaison for your conference transportation plan.

WHAT KINDS OF OFF-CAMPUS ACTIVITIES WILL YOU OFFER?

CHIC Excursions seeks to offer students fun and adventurous activities that will enhance the CHIC experience.
